B. Qualification for Admission:

Candidates seeking admission into one of the above mentioned programs must have the following qualifications:

- 1. The applicant must complete twelve-year (12) education (e.g. A-Level/O-Level in the British Education System or equivalent examination) not before 2018.
- 2. S/he has to secure CGPA 3.5 under the scale of 5 or CGPA 3 under the scale of 4 or 70% Marks in A-Level, British education system or equivalent examination.

- 3. S/he must secure CGPA 3.5 under the scale of 5 or CGPA 3 under the scale of 4 or 70% Marks in O-Level, British education system or equivalent examination.
- Academic background of applicants should match with the undergraduate program that they intend to be enrolled.
- 5. Applicants from British education system must secure C grade at both 'O' and 'A' levels with no 'D' grade in any subject.
- 6. S/he must submit the proof of his/her English proficiency.

E. Application Process:

- (a) Students from abroad shall apply in the Prescribed Form to be downloaded from the web site of Islamic University, Kushtia, Bangladesh (https://www.iu.ac.bd/index.php/notice/index/NjU=/MzEy) and submit it to one of the following e-mails: (1) isac@iu.ac.bd (2) saadat2152@gmail.com
- (b) The following scanned copies of the documents must be sent with the Application Form:
 - (i) All Academic Certificates.
 - (ii) Authenticated Transcripts of all Marks/Grades secured leading to qualifying examination.
 - (iii) Passport Size Photograph.
 - (iv) A copy of detailed syllabus/courses studied in the last examination passed.
 - (v) Certificate of Proficiency in English/Arabic.
 - (vi) Student's valid passport.
 - (vii) Testimonial certificate from last educational institute.
 - (viii) Police clearance certificate from Home Ministry of the applicant.

(c) Incomplete application shall not be considered for evaluation.

F. Important Information:

- International students are exempted from admission test if the number of applicants is less than the reserved seat.
- Students must show the original Transcripts/ Mark Sheets, Certificates of each qualifying examination at the time of admission.
- Students who are finally selected for admission would have to undergo a medical examination and be declared fit to pursue the prescribed course of studies.
- International students with outstanding academic achievement will be eligible to apply for full or partial tuition fee waiver.
- A number of scholarships will also be offered to international students based on their academic performances.
- For international students there are adequate residential, medical and transport facilities.

G. Residential Facilities:

International students who will get admission under this program will be provided with full-furnished residential facilities in the International Students' Block of Jatir Pita Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman Hall and Sheikh Russel Hall for male students and Deshratna Sheikh Hasina Hall for the female students.
